Your payment when enrolling a house in the R-2000 program does not ensure that a house passes the requirements to be R-2000 certified.

The Initial Design Evaluation shows if your house meets the requirements of the R-2000 Standard and also what upgrades you might need if your design did not meet the requirements.

READ IT carefully to see if what you plan to build is the same as the requirements shown on this report. Here are a few common items that could be different from your planned construction:

- HRV model - must meet air flow and efficiency requirements
- Energy Upgrades
- R-values of house components
- Design Heat Loss - use to confirm heating system size

Don't forget your Pre-Drywall Inspection.

This inspection ensures that you are still building the same house with the components assumed at the initial Design Evaluation stage. It is also very helpful in finding possible air leakage areas before they are hidden by drywall.

Included in the cost of enrolment is:

- One plan evaluation
- One pre-drywall inspection
- One air tightness test with the final inspection

If you require a remedial air tightness test or inspection or if your house design changes such that the evaluation must be re-done, you will be responsible for these additional charges.
